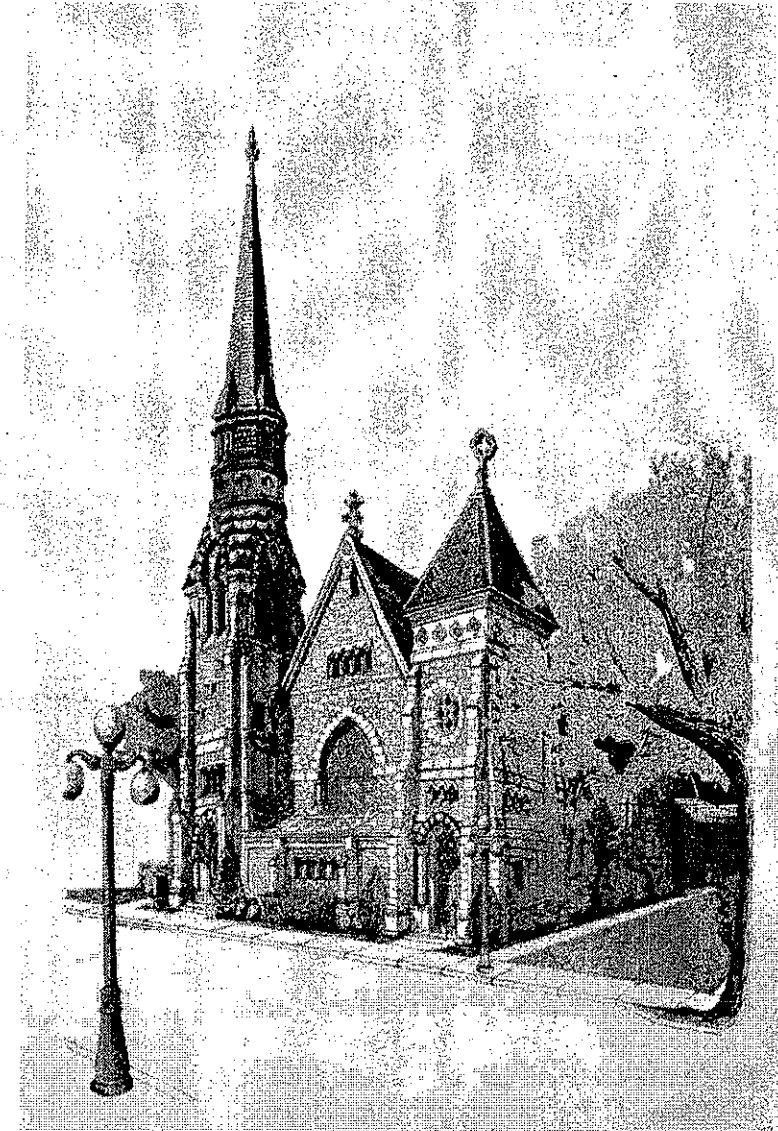

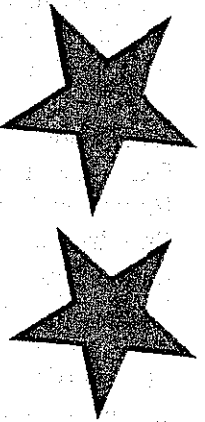

Nursery
